- i. The manuscripts must be in accordance with the topics of the conference.
- ii. The manuscripts must be written according to the HEC Anti Plagiarism Policy.
- iii. The manuscripts must follow the general rules of research and should be free from all sorts of errors.
- iv. The manuscripts must not be submitted to any other conference or research journal.
- v. The Quranic verses and the Ahadith must be cited along with the original text.
- vi. The Chicago 16th Footnote Style must be adopted for citations.
- vii. The manuscripts must have an Abstract of about 300 words.
- viii. The manuscripts must be composed in Microsoft Word.
- ix. The manuscripts should be 15-20 pages.
- x. The manuscripts must be prepared on A4 size paper with 1 margin on all sides. Font for Urdu should be Jameel Nori Nastaleeq, for English, Times New Roman, and for Arabic, Traditional Arabic.
- xi. The manuscripts must be submitted in both hard and soft copy.
- xii. The submitted manuscripts will be evaluated through the Blind Peer Review process. The decision to accept or reject a manuscript rests solely with the Conference Committee
